Special City Council Meeting
Council Chambers, July 29, 2010, 12:00 pm

The Griswold City Council met in special session at City Hall. Mayor Putnam called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. Council present: Adams, Rink, Bergstrom, Wyman and Carlisle.

Motion by Wyman to approve the agenda; seconded by Adams. Approved 5-0

PUBLIC HEARING

Mayor Putnam opened the Public Hearing for **Ordinance 3-2010-An Ordinance Adopting the City of Griswold, Code of Ordinances, 2010**. There being no written or oral comments, Mayor Putnam closed the Public Hearing.

ORDINANCES

- a. Motion by Rink approving the **Third and Final Reading – Ordinance 3-2010 an Ordinance Adopting the City of Griswold, Code of Ordinance, 2010**. Seconded by Bergstrom. Roll Call ayes: Adams, Rink, Bergstrom, Wyman and Carlisle. Nays: None. Motion approved.
- b. Motion by Adams to **Adopt Ordinance 3-2010**. Seconded by Wyman. Roll Call ayes: Carlisle, Rink, Adams, Bergstrom and Wyman. Nays: none. Ordinance 3-2010 Adopted.

NEW BUSINESS

- a. Motion by Wyman to approve **Resolution 3-2011 – Resolution for Support for IJOBS II Grant Application**. Seconded by Adams. Roll Call ayes: Rink, Wyman, Carlisle, Adams and Bergstrom. Nays: none. Resolution 3-2011 Adopted.
- b. The **Approval to Purchase a Pump for the Upper Lift Station** was tabled until the August 16th Meeting, council would like to see another estimate.
- c. City Manager, Jessica Kinser informed the council of the “Keep Iowa Beautiful” grants available. Under the grant guidelines the Yard Waste Site could potentially qualify for a maximum amount of \$5,000. Council would like to see if there might be any other areas beside the Yard Waste Site that would qualify. Also, depending on what the Council wishes to do with 803 Main St., a \$15,000 grant could help with the removal of the building. Council would like Kinser to pursue the grant available to assist in the removal of the building at 803 Main St.
