The Griswold City Council met for a special meeting at City Hall. Mayor Lee Wyman called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Council present: J. Wyman, Askeland, Adams, Mundorf and Cook.

Motion by Askeland to approve the agenda. Seconded by Cook. Approved 5-0.

NEW BUSINESS

- a. Motion by Askeland to offer the **Public Works Assistant** position to Aaron Hartman. Seconded by Mundorf. - b. Council discussed stipulations for the sale of city property. Lot 811 Main: council discussed requiring a 2400 minimum square footage building hooked up to sewer and water within two years of sale or the city can take it back. Lot 803 Main: council does not want any stipulations. They want to sell both properties by sealed bid with a minimum bid of \$500 on each lot.
