## General Policy/Procedure

### Use of City Park Facilities

**ADOPTION DATE:** October 10, 2011

**RESOLUTION NUMBER:** 7-2012

**REVIEW PERIOD:** This policy is to be reviewed every three years or as needed.

#### **STATEMENT OF POLICY**

The City allows reservations to be made for the use of the bandshell/stage or the shelter at the City Park.

#### **APPLICABILITY**

This policy applies to the bandshell/stage and shelter at the City Park.

#### **DEFINITIONS**

None.

#### **POLICY AND PROCEDURE**

The City of Griswold allows individuals and organizations to utilize the bandshell/stage and shelter at the City Park. A \$50 deposit is required, which is refundable so long as the reserved facility is left in the same condition it was found. The hours of reservations are limited to those of the Park, which are from 6 A.M. to 11 P.M. The stage of the bandshell is to be used for entertainment purposes only. No picnic tables or grills shall be used on the stage.

Motorized vehicles are restricted to established roadways and parking areas.

All pets must be on a leash and all droppings must be immediately cleaned up and disposed of in a proper manner.

The use of any dangerous or destructive instruments, including but not limited to firearms, B.B. guns, bows and arrows, and golf balls, is strictly prohibited.

Alcoholic beverages are allowed in the City Park, but may not be consumed on the play areas or basketball court. Kegs and containers larger than one quart are prohibited unless a liquor license is authorized by the City Council. Glass containers are prohibited.

Litter is to be deposited into trash receptacles and the shelter and surrounding areas must be left clean in order to receive the \$50 deposit back.
