Work Session, Community Building Small Room
March 27, 2019

Mayor Brad Rhine opened the work session at 6:00 p.m. in the Griswold Community Building Small Room. Council present: Sorensen, Askeland, Preston, Cook, Adams.

1. Pavement Management Plan Update

- a. Lenny Larson with ISG gave a presentation on the preliminary construction plans for paving Park, North and Maple Streets. The new streets will be constructed of 4 inch asphalt, 6 inch curb, a crushed stone subbase and a sub-drain to help storm water flow. The roadway from curb to curb will span 26 feet, allowing for on-street parking. As part of the project, they plan to address the current storm water issues by installing a larger storm outlet pipe on the northwest side of the park, cleaning and re-grading the ditch that leads to “no name” creek, installing more storm sewer intakes and putting in an open-throat storm water system. Ditch cleaning and prep work is to begin early summer and actual reconstruction of the streets will occur after July 13th (Griswold Old Soldier’s Reunion) through September. Copies of the preliminary construction plans are available at city hall for review.

2. Public Comments

- a. There were a handful of questions from the public. Concerns included: sidewalk replacement, access to homes during construction, current storm water issues and how they would be resolved, street width extending into property owner’s yards, disturbance in water and sewer service, etc.
